CFS Heritage Report to CFSVA

AGM October 18th 2011

Listed below are a few of the major outcomes from the CFS Heritage Committee during the last twelve months.

- A Swat - Analysis on the future of the CFS Heritage conducted in January
- It was decided to locate and construct a CFS Museum at the Sheep's Back Museum Naracoorte.
- Meetings with National Trust, Council and a number of other stakeholders involved.
- Approval from all in principal.
- *This process has taken much longer than what I imagined it would.*
- However at long last the final Constitution was presented to the committee on Monday for ratification after a 14 day consultation period.
- Extension of lease approved with Show Society.
- Agreement reached with CFS in regard to funding until approval of Constitution.
- Obtained and recorded names of **30 Volunteers** who have expressed their interest in being involved in the South Australian Volunteer Firefighters Museum at Naracoorte.
- As a result of the above briefing a Working Party of 8 members was formed to further investigate a number of the options tabled.
- Obtaining cost of Insurance and other cost of running the above Museum.
- An architect draftsman (CFS member) has volunteered to draw up plans free of charge.

- The working party agreed to co – opt a builder onto the working party for advice and costing.
- There has been one change of delegate to the State Heritage committee with Mike Sandford replacing long term delegate Ray Bryant in Region 2. The Heritage committee wish to acknowledge and thank Ray for his long and dedicated service to the committee.
