Checklist for “Distinguished Service”

Criterion “Distinguished Service”
Has nominee demonstrated service <i>beyond the norm</i> exemplified in more than one of the following elements:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prolonged service distinguished by exceptional performance in a particular area that has proved of significant benefit to the fire service, for example;<ul style="list-style-type: none">• development of successful fire control techniques;• exceptional service through training and/or community education;• outstanding service in fire prevention/protection,
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Responsibility for and management of an outstanding/exceptional event that has proven to be of significant benefit to the fire service, a community or community safety generally,
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Development of a new system, or procedure, or technique that is unique and has made a significant contribution to the fire service a community or community safety generally,
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Outstanding leadership in the encouragement and development of others, particularly youth, within the fire service and the fostering and furthering the aims of the fire service to the long term benefit of the fire service and the community,
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demonstrated creativity in the development and implementation of innovative changes that have made a significant contribution to the fire service, fire/emergency operations, or the interests of community safety,
